

INSTALLING THE CHARACTERS ON YOUR NEW CANAMEX PORTABLE SIGN

Characters made of corrugated plastic that is somewhat flexible and are very lightweight.

Most signs produced utilizing the 7" character are fitted with "lift and load" tracking. This system allows the character to be inserted into the track directly above and simply dropped down to rest on the track directly below the character. There is no need to flex the character in order to insert them into the tracking.

Character of 9" or taller are designed to flex when placing in position on the sign face. The procedure for inserting these characters into the tracking is to place the bottom edge of the character into the track in which it will rest upon. Pull the character slightly toward your body and using your thumbs and forefingers simply flex the character to fit into the track directly above.

Due to the lightweight nature of the corrugated plastic material strong winds may cause the characters shift. It is recommended that the first and last character of each word be fastened to the sign face. Simply staple the character to the face using a

3/8" staple. To change the message on the sign use a flat edge tool like a blade screw driver and simply pop the staple out of the character prior to removing from the sign face.

When using the large 21" characters, it is recommended to use a wafer head screw one near the top and one near the bottom of the character to fasten them to the sign face. This will provide security from the winds lifting the character from the sign face.
